CINEMATOGRAPHS AND CINEMATOGRAPH FILMS

The Cinematograph Regulations, 1953

Made - - - - - 23rd April, 1953
Coming into Operation 1st May, 1953

In pursuance of the powers conferred on me by section one of the Cinematograph Act, 1909(a), I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. The provisions of the Cinematograph Regulations, 1950(b), which are specified in the first column of the Schedule to these Regulations (being certain of the provisions relating to television) and which relate in particular to the requirements specified in the second column of the said Schedule, are hereby revoked.
2. These Regulations may be cited as the Cinematograph Regulations, 1953, and shall come into operation on the first day of May, 1953.

SCHEDULE

PROVISIONS OF THE CINEMATOGRAPH REGULATIONS, 1950. REVOKED

Provisions revoked	Requirements to which the provisions relate
Regulation 24	Requirement that the metal conduit or ducting enclosing the electrical wiring or conductors supplying the energy shall contain no other circuit or sub-circuit conductors.
Regulation 26	Requirement as to the provision of special means to disconnect the circuit when normal methods of protection against excess current cannot be applied.
Regulation 27	Requirements as to the apparatus or equipment for transferring or converting the low pressure supply to a voltage above 650 volts.
Paragraphs (i) and (iv) of Regulation 28.	Requirements as to the casing in which a television projector is to be enclosed, and the keeping of a clear space around the projector.
Regulation 30	Requirement that the voltage between the conductors or between a conductor and earth within the control unit shall not exceed 650 volts, and application of the requirements of Regulation 26 to the control unit.
Regulation 34	Requirement that equipment shall be tested with particular requirements as to evacuated vessels and automatic relays.
Regulation 36	Requirement that cathode ray tubes shall not be changed while members of the public are upon the premises.
